- Ocelots are members of the cat family.
- Female ocelots weigh 14.5 to 25 pounds while the males weigh 15 to 34 pounds.
- They are nocturnal and typically hunt at night for small rodents.
- Ocelots can be found from southern Texas to northern Argentina.
- Ocelots prefer to live in areas with dense forest cover and water sources. This can include tropical forests, mangrove swamps, and savannas.

Ocelots are on the brink of extinction due mostly to habitat destruction.
