# **All About Cookies**

## **Important Information**

#### 2023 Cookie Season

The 2023 Cookie Season has now closed and the Smart Cookie system is locked.

#### ACH Sweep

The final ACH Sweep will occur on May 1. Please make sure you deposit all monies due to Council before that date.

If your troop participated after March 20 you may see two different sweeps. One will be through the Smart Cookie system for any remaining balances due to Council, (see Troop Balance Summary for accurate calculations) and the second will be for any discounted packages picked up between April 5 - 21 not listed in Smart Cookie.

#### **Rewards and Bonuses**

All Spring Renewal Bonus' have been applied to the troop payment sections. This will be deducted from the final sweep or reverse swept back to the troops if needed after May 1.

Rewards have been ordered and are scheduled to arrive to the SUPPM's by Mid-May.

Higher Level Rewards have been ordered and will arrive via Amazon delivery. Tent bundles will come through Walmart.

#### **Cookie Dough**

Online Cookie Dough has been sent to all parents with codes to spend. Enter the code at checkout in the Gift Certificate field, not the promo code field.

Card form Cookie Dough has been ordered and is scheduled to arrive and be processed for a Mid-May delivery or pick up from a local council office by the SUPPM's to distribute to leaders.

#### **Cookie Donations**

We had a very successful donation program this season. Helen Devos Children's Hospital, GR Veterans Home, Feeding America, Father Fred's in Traverse City, and Sus Manos Gleaners are just a few of the deserving donation sites who will be receiving Girl Scout cookies in the next coming weeks. This program makes a huge impact in our local community.

## **Policy Reminders**

Please remember, per GSMISTS Volunteer Policy and Procedures, if a girl has participated in fall and cookies with her troop and applies for FA for membership, the troop should be covering those registration fees.

If you receive an email from Sally Ellis regarding this payment issue, please re-register the girl ASAP so we can close the case. The procedure is referenced below.

From page 26 of GSMISTS Volunteer Policies and Procedures:

- Financial assistance for girls and adults is subject to the availability of funds within GSMISTS operating budget.
- Troops who have had the opportunity to participate in the Fall Product Program and the Cookie Program should use troop funds to renew girl and leader memberships.

The Resilient. Ready. Strong. patch will build girls' inner strength, so they are ready for anything! This 15-minute course for troop leaders and volunteers will review activities that work for all grade levels, as well as provide reflective questions for discussion with girls, and links to additional resources. Access gsLearn through your MY GS account.

#### Small Craft Safety Training | Greenville

Learn and practice small craft safety! This training permits GS volunteers to facilitate canoeing and kayaking with their Girl Scouts.

Please note, this is a HYBRID training. Completion of this course involves:

- 1. Completing gsLearn video modules (Approximately 30 min in length)
- 2. Passing online exam prior to in-person training (80% or higher) (approximately 30 minutes total test time)
- 3. Successfully completing the in-person training and skills assessment with GSMISTS

Participants must demonstrate: Swimming ability, shore-based rescues, on-water rescues, self-rescues, and supported rescues for other boaters. This training is valid for 2 years after completion.
