

Gold Award Girl Scouts



Katherine Bell Grand Rapids, MI

Bell's "Collars and Microchips Project" created awareness around the importance of using collars and microchipping cats to prevent the euthanization of cats brought into shelters. Katherine created and organized an awareness day around the issue at Crash's Landing and Big Sid's Sanctuary which will continue to be held annually.

Dana Brouse Rockford, MI

Brouse's "Sanctuary of Hope Project" created a healing garden at Safe Haven Ministries for women and children affected by domestic violence seeking shelter and/or counseling. For her project, Dana created structures, collected the materials needed, and organized the building of the garden.



Emily Duell Alto, MI

Duell's "Recognizing the Veterans Project" addressed the veteran's graves being missed during Memorial Day flag ceremonies at Bowne Township Cemetery. She remapped the cemetery, marking graves of each veteran buried so all will be recognized in the future.

Shelby Mott Fremont, MI

Mott's "Recycled Toddler Playground Project" created a safe space for young children to play at her family's place of worship. The playground was made of recycled materials and featured a playhouse, stepping stones and even a music wall.



Elizabeth Nelson Manistee, MI

Nelson's "Green Acres Root Beer Float Project" addressed elderly loneliness at the Green Acres Retirement Living in Manistee. By connecting residents of Green Acres with the community, everyone could spend meaningful time together.

Claire Peterson Spring Lake, MI

Peterson's "Hand in Hand Project" was designed to build a team and a sustainable system to provide common hygiene products to low income and homeless students in the Spring Lake community. The goal was to equally involve the schools, the church and the community.



Hannah Pins Big Rapids, MI

Pins' "Community Pantry Cookbook Project" was formed while working with Project Starburst, a local food pantry in Big Rapids. Hannah noticed several food items being neglected and took action, creating a cookbook. The cookbook teaches families proper cooking techniques and recipes, giving them the confidence in the kitchen to create nutritious meals for their families.





Stephanie Postmaa Grand Rapids, MI

Postmaa's "Free Little Libraries for Elementary Students Project" worked to increase reading among students at Thornapple Elementary School. She created a Little Free Library and organized a book drive which resulted in over 200 books being distributed to students.

Abigail Rosiak Holland, MI

Rosiak's "Letterboxing for Benjamin's Hope Project" worked with a rehabilitation center for young adults with developmental disabilities to create an interactive activity along their nature trail to help connect their patients with nature.





Alexandria Snabes Charlevoix, MI

Snabes' "Charlevoix Mini Library Project" created three environmentally-friendly 'Mini Libraries' located along the beaches of Charlevoix. The three libraries offer children and adult books and were built out of recycled materials.

Cookie Program

The Girl Scout Cookie Program® teaches girls about entrepreneurship as they have fun learning essential skills like money management, public speaking, and decision making, which sets them up for a lifetime of success. Nine in ten Girl Scouts say the cookie program has built their entrepreneurship skills and their interest in pursuing entrepreneurship as a career path—so every cookie purchase is an investment in the world-changing business leaders of tomorrow.




