Program Partners receive advertisement, exposure, and increased revenue through the premier leadership development program for girls.


Types of Programs

Date-and-time events

Partners who want to offer special events listed to our entire membership through the GSMISTS event calendar may choose to develop unique date-and-time events. Held once, monthly, semi-annually, or even once a year – you can decide what works best for you!

Programs On Demand

Partners may choose to offer a Program On Demand. These opportunities are scheduled by individual troops on a case-by-case basis.



What programs look like

Partners can create programs based around their own content and develop a 'fun patch' or work with the GSMISTS Girl Experience team to create badge or journey earning opportuntiies.

Badges

Awards girls earn by completing skill building activities - curriculum set by Girl Scouts of the United States of America.

Journeys

A series of badges or awards that include a sustainable take action project - curriculum set by Girl Scouts of the United States of America.

Patches

Given to Girl Scouts for participating in fun events, activities, or programs that are not a part of the Girl Scout curriculum.

- You will be asked to upload a copy of your business/organization's liability insurance and logo.
- Nonprofits will be asked for a tax exemption certificate.
- Optional promotional tier fee may be paid on-line via debit or credit. (Form will redirect to PayPal, however a PayPal account is not needed to pay. Invoices or receipt of payment are available upon request.)

Step 2: Submit Program Information

- A Girl Experience Team Member will contact you to develop and publish your event(s).
- It is suggested that you submit your events 3-4 months out to allow time for promotion and registration.
