Programs Offered			
First Aide Badge & Safety Award Pin 	\$20-50/Girl Troop Leaders free	5 min 20 max	Program available as combo or individual badge/pin program and takes 2-3 hours to complete. Cost includes earned award(s).
Each program focuses on the unique safety and first aid requirements by Girl Scout level. Discover safety measures you can take to protect yourselves and your family from harm, then put your knowledge to use through hands activities and exercises.			
SafeSitter Babysitter Training 	\$95/Girl Troop Leaders free	4 min 20 max	Cost includes SafeSitter completion card, completion, SafeSitter Kit, and earned Babysitter Badges for Cadettes. Program duration is 8 hours.
This SafeSitter babysitting safety training program features interactive demonstrations and hands-on skills stations where Girl Scouts learn everything they need to know to keep little ones safe and happy while their caregivers are away. Includes SafeSitter completion card, SafeSitter Kit, and earned badges for Cadettes.			
Women's Health Badge 	\$25/Girl Troop Leaders free	2 min 20 max	Cost includes earned badges. 3 hour program.
Chat with a women's health provider in her office about the medical screenings and procedures necessary to keep you healthy. Learn about fads in the beauty and diet industries and how to navigate them. Create an inspirational craft. Practice guided meditation, yoga, and other techniques that promote emotional health.			
First Aid CPR/AED Training 	\$40-\$100/person	4 min 24 max	Cost and program length vary by desired course content.
American Heart Association and American Red Cross certification are both available. In-person training is provided by a highly skilled instructor with years of EMS experience. Class can be offered as CPR (4hr), First Aid (2hr), or CPR & First Aid combined (6hr). Certification is available to any age physically able to complete the skills test.			
Wilderness First Aid 	\$180/person	4 min 12 max	16 hour program split into 2 days. Students must be 14+ and have current CPR certification card. Cost includes WFA Certificate, resource book, field notebook, and patch.
Learn how to respond to more than 25 first aid emergencies in the backwoods when help may be delayed. This 16 hour course, split over two days, uses the wilderness as your classroom to learn how to provide effective treatment and make appropriate evacuation decisions and it critical knowledge for anyone leading adventure or backcountry camping trips. Class held outdoors regardless of weather.
