

Betsy Cutler House

The Betsy Cutler House is named after lifetime Girl Scout and volunteer Betsy Cutler. This facility is conveniently located off US 31 in North Muskegon and is used year-round for trainings, badge workshops, day camps, special events, and overnights.

Lodging/Accommodations

- Sleeps up to 50 with mattresses
 - Bunk room with 3 bunks and mattresses (sleeps 6)
 - Additional space for mattresses
- Linens are NOT provided (you are responsible for pillows, blankets, towels, etc.)
- Full kitchen with pots/pans, plates/flatware, microwave, coffee maker, full size electric stove/oven and refrigerator
- 6 Bathrooms with toilets and 3 with showers
- Activity area for meals and crafts
- Tents are permitted

Property Information

- Property includes wetlands, wooded lot, 4 large ponds, and a creek
- Picnic tables and campfire area for outdoor cooking
- Outdoor amphitheater with campfire ring (seats 100)
- Wetland boardwalk
- Nature trails
- Archery Range (requires a trained volunteer)
- On-site parking

Rental Rates

The entire rental fee is due upon reservation.

Day Use: \$25 (Sat/Sun must pay overnight rates)

1 Night: \$50

2 Nights: \$100

Outside Organization

Day Use: \$50 (Sat/Sun must pay overnight rates)

1 Night: \$140

1 Night Non-profit: \$100

2 Nights: \$280

2 Nights Non-profit: \$200

Activity/Trip Application

All travel and overnights must be approved by GSMISTS by submitting the [Activity/Trip application](#).

Overnights, day trips lasting longer than 8 hours, and high adventure/high risk activity (any activity in Safety Activity Checkpoints that requires GSMISTS approval) needs to be submitted to GSMISTS at least 4 weeks prior to date of overnight/activity.

Extended trips of three (3) or more nights needs to be submitted to GSMISTS at least 6 weeks prior to date of travel.
